ACT 1

SONG 1 - INTRODUCTION

Introduction plays. Curtains open. Bill, Ben and Betty stood holding a big book. Willy Wonka walks wistfully in the background looking happily at his factory.

Betty: Welcome to chocolate paradise

Ben: We are Ben,

Bill: Bill

Betty: and Betty

Ben: Oompa Loompas from Loompaland

Bill: We're here to tell you a story

Betty: A story sweeter than chocolate itself

Ben: It's about this guy, Mr Willy Wonka [beckons Wonka over]

Wonka: Oh, hello friends [waves to audience] welcome to my factory! Full of chocolate,

sweets and pure imagination

Bill: It wasn't easy to get to where he is today. Years of hard work, determination,

Ben: ...A lot of help from us

Wonka: ...and this hat full of dreams

Bill: Got him where he is today

Wonka: And I'm pretty darn proud of it!

Exit Wonka

SONG 2 – A HATFUL OF DREAMS – PREINTERMEDIATE TAP

START OFF STAGE – entering from both sides when music starts

PreInter Tap bow, stay on start whispering, pointing, pretending to steal things from Boxes (STAGE HAND to put on stage) and put in pockets.

Wonka runs in

Wonka: Oi! What are you all doing? You're supposed to be my workforce, my friends! You're

stealing my creations! You're all fired!

PreIntermediate Tap cross arms, stamp foot and march off stage angrily.

Wonka takes map out of pocket

Wonka: I need to find some new workers. Loyal, kind people I can trust. Hmm [looks at map]

Loompaland, I remember harvesting some cacao there once. Maybe there's some

chocolate experts there that will fit the bill.

Exit Wonka, Enter Junior Tap

SONG 3 – OOMPA LOOMPA MIX – JUNIOR TAP

START ON STAGE – Adele will bring the dancers on to their starting positions (2 lines)

Junior Tap bow, stay on stage. Enter Wonka

Wonka: Oh mighty Oompa Loompas, come and live with me in my factory. Together we'll make

the most magical chocolate the world has ever seen.

Junior Tap huddle to think about it then turn to Wonka and give thumbs up. All leave.

Enter Barry Broadcast, with bar of chocolate.

Barry: Good evening, this is the 6 O'Clock news with me Barry Broadcast. News just in, Wonka

sacks entire workforce – but the factory continues to produce record levels of delicious chocolate. Who's making it? It's a mystery. But frankly, who cares when it tastes this good! I've never tasted chocolate like this, incredible! [Barry leaves munching on the

chocolate looking disbelieved how delicious it is]

Exit Barry, enter Adult Tap

SONG 4 – YOU'VE NEVER HAD CHOCOLATE LIKE THIS – ADULT TAP

START ON STAGE – facing back in a pose

STAGE HANDS – ready each side to collect in hats

Adult Tap bow and exit, enter Wonka

Wonka: I really have it all, but no one to leave it to when I'm gone. I need to find someone with

imagination and belief. I need to find a child to give my factory to. I have a plan!

Exit Wonka, Enter Mrs Bucket, Grandpa Joe, Grandpa George, Grandma Josephine, Grandma Georgina. Grandparents all holding a blanket to look like they're in bed – Grandma Josephine sleeping.

George: What's for dinner?

Mrs Bucket: Cabbage Water, Grandpa George

Georgina: Again? But I'm starving!

Mrs Bucket: I'm sorry Grandma Georgina, it's all we can afford. With all of you bedridden for the last

20 years, it takes a lot of work to even get cabbage water on the table.

Grandpa Joe: When I get my strength back, I'm going to get out of this bed and help

Mrs Bucket: Grandpa Joe, all these years you've been saying that, and I'm yet to see you step a foot

on the floor.

Josephine: [wakes up with a start] Where am I?! What have I missed?

Charlie: You're at home Grandma Josephine

Josephine: Oh, right... [Falls back asleep again]

Charlie: I just wish we had a little bit more, mum

Mrs Bucket: I know Charlie, but I'm afraid life's a rich man's game. We just have to do what we can.

Enter Megan, Hannah, Ettie and Ellie

Megan W: Mrs Bucket, are you ready?

Hannah D: We're going to be late for work

Ettie A: That café won't open itself

Ellie F: And you know how angry the boss gets if we don't open on time

Mrs Bucket: I'm coming. Cheer up Charlie, things will change, I just know it.

Exit Mrs Bucket left and rest of family right. Enter rest of Inter Tap

SONG 5: MONEY MONEY — INTERMEDIATE TAP

START ON STAGE – in starting pose with their tea trays

Inter Tap bow. Enter Mrs Bucket

Isabelle P: Work is over, are you coming Mrs Bucket?

Darcey B: We're going to the pub!

Mrs Bucket: I can't, I have a shift at the laundrette next, and cleaning the offices across the way after

that.

Lianna M: Blimey! You be careful Mrs Bucket. You'll spend so much time working, you'll have no

time to live life.

Exit Inters, Enter Senior Ballet

SONG 6 – SHE USED TO BE MINE - PRESENIOR AND SENIOR BALLET (Anna Wiggins to miss final section?)

1/2 of group START ON STAGE – standing looking downwards

Exit PreSenior and Seniors. Enter Ballet 2 (Sundays – Donut hair clip) placed by Adele

After Ballet 2 placed, enter the Candy Man [Apron, hat and bow tie over ballet costume, cane]

Candy Man: Roll up, roll up. Sweet shop open today! We have Slugworth Sizzlers, Prodnose Originals,

Ficklegrober Fancies, and everyone's favourites – Wonka Bars!

SONG 7 - THE CANDY MAN - SATURDAY AND SUNDAY BALLET 2

1/2 START ON STAGE – entering from both sides when music starts

Exit Ballet 2, Enter Barry Broadcast with multiple bars of chocolate, pretending to finish eating before he speaks. And enter Inter Modern – speakers stand at front of group near microphones, holding their own mic props.

Barry: It's me, Barry Broadcast, my gosh this chocolate is good. We have breaking news, let's

go to our roving reporters.

Bella B: Thank you Barry, what a story this is!

Orla M: Willy Wonka has today released 5 golden tickets

Agnes K: The golden tickets allow the holders a tour of Wonka's factory

Naomi J: and a lifetime's supply of chocolate!

Caitlin C: They're hidden in just 5 Wonka Bars

Mari C: The world is looking for them!

Hughie T: I think it's going to be a crazy few days

Olivia S: Don't worry, us reporters are here to tell you all about it as the news unfolds

Annabella B: Back to the studio!

Exit Barry, Inter Modern get into starting positions

SONG 8 – NEWS OF THE WORLD – INTERMEDIATE MODERN

START ON STAGE – in starting pose

Inter Modern bow and all exits except May and Alice

May T: We're here in the village of Quorn where Wonka mania has taken hold

Alice K: Everyone is searching for a golden tickets, who will find one first?

Exit May and Alice

Stagehand: Put 3 Wonka boxes on each side of stage

SONG 9 - I WANT CANDY - PREINTERMEDIATE MODERN

START OFF STAGE – peeping in and out from both sides when music starts

ADELE – GO TO BACK OF THEATRE

Preintermediate Modern bow and exit, enter Auctioneer.

Auctioneer: [To audience] Right, order, order, calm down everyone. Welcome to the AMC Auction

House. Todays lot – the last 3 known boxes of Wonka bars in the UK. Here they are... [Adele brings boxes through audience to the stage]

Auctioneer: Can we start the bidding at ten thousand pounds? Twenty thousand... fifty... a hundred...

half a million... one million pounds.... five million... ten million pounds! Sold – to Mr

Barry Broadcast.

Exit Auctioneer enter Barry Broadcast

Barry: I'll be taking these delicious beauties – put them in my car. [Exit Adele with boxes]

Oh and by the way, Breaking news folks, the first ticket has been found in the small town

of Dusselheim in Germany.

Exit Barry. Enter Mrs Gloop and Augustus [Mrs Gloop dragging Augustus by hand, Augustus eating chocolate and holding a gold ticket]

Mrs Gloop: Here he is, my little winner! Tell them Augustus, tell them all how you feel!

Augustus: Hungry!

Mrs Gloop: Oh my little shnookums, he really does love his chocolate!

Augustus: And now I've won a lifetime supply!

Enter Prodnose

Prodnose: Hey boy, come here, I have a way you can double the chocolate Wonka will give you

Prodnose whispers in Augustus ear

Mrs Gloop: I'm so proud of you my little prince! And look, the whole town has put on a celebration

just for you!

Exit Barry Broadcast, Prodnose, Mrs Gloop and Augustus

Enter Tishya and Belle

Tishya: Welcome to Germany!

Belle S: Let's celebrate Augustus Gloop finding the first golden ticket!

Exit Tishya and Belle.

SONG 10 - GERMAN FOLKDANCE - INTERMEDIATE BALLET

START OFF STAGE – entering from both sides when music starts

Intermediate Ballet exit

Enter Salts Nut Workers – stand stage left miming unwrapping Wonka bars each holding a bar (Charlottes has gold ticket hidden); Veruca, Mr Salt and Mrs Salt stand stage right

Veruca: I wanted to be the first to find a golden ticket Daddy

Mr Salt: I know angel, we're doing the best we can. I've got every worker in the factory searching

for you.

Veruca: Well where is it? Why haven't they found it?!

Mr Salt: For five days now the whole factory has been on the job, they haven't shelled a peanut in

there since Monday. They've been shelling chocolate bars from dawn until dusk.

Veruca: Make them work nights!

Mrs Salt: You're going to be very unpopular if you don't find her that ticket very soon

Veruca, Mr Salt and Mrs Salt Freeze

Cleo: I don't think I can take much more of this

Gracie: We must have unwrapped thousands already

Charlotte: Wait, what's this!? [pulls out ticket]

Alice: You've found one! That's a Golden Ticket!

Cleo: Wow! What are you going to do with it?

Gracie: You should keep it, that brat doesn't deserve it.

Charlotte: I don't really know. Won't I get in trouble if I keep it?

Alice: They're looking, quick hide it before they see...

The Salts are peering, Veruca spots the ticket and marches over

Veruca: The golden ticket! It's mine

Charlotte and Veruca tug at ticket before Veruca snatches it

Mrs Salt: Thank goodness for that

Enter Ficklegrober

Ficklegrober: Miss Salt, can I have a word, I have a way you can turn that prize into every material

desire you have ever had. [Puts arm around Veruca] A material girl like you deserves the very best. You deserve to live in a material world, let me explain [Leads Veruca off

stage]

Exit all, Enter Adult Jazz

SONG 11 - MATERIAL GIRL - ADULT MODERN & JAZZ

START ON STAGE - in starting poses

Adult Modern & Jazz bow and exit

Enter Mrs Bouregard

Mrs Bouregard: [Blows Whistle] Violet, we need to practice that again. We must be the best!

Violet cartwheels in and poses, Mrs Bouregard walks over and adjusts Violet's pose

Mrs Bouregard: More smiles, more poise, more more more! Come on Violet, remember - winners focus

on winning, losers focus on winners.

Exit Mrs Bouregard

Violet: But I have won. Ticket number 3 is mine! Of course, that's not good enough for my

mother. There's always the next competition, the next trophy, the next win. [Sighs and

looks at ticket those other ticket holders better watch out, I'll be the best.

Enter Slugworth [In commercial costume with jacket over the top]

Slugworth: Violet Bouregard? I have a proposal for you, how would you like to not be A ticket winner,

but be the BEST of the winners. Overall champion you may say.

Slugworth takes off jacket, and walks off with Violet whispering as they go.

Enter senior commercial

SONG 12 - SENIOR COMMERCIAL

START ON STAGE - Start in pose

Exit Commercial, Enter Mike Teevee playing game on video controller and holding gold ticket, Mrs Teevee with a calculator, and reporter Matilda and Isabelle Hornsby with their mics.

Matilda H: We're here in Denver, Colorado, USA, where ticket number 4 has just been found! Here's

Mrs Teevee and her son Mike – the lucky finder of a golden ticket

Mrs Teevee: Oh hello, are we live?! Good morning everyone!

Mike: Can you keep it down, I've got a top score on this game.

Isabelle H: How does it feel Mike, to win a golden ticket? What amazing luck to find it!

Mike: Luck! It wasn't luck, all I had to do was check the manufacture dates, offset by weather

and divide by 57. An idiot could have worked it out.

Mrs Teevee: It's simple maths really. Are we still live? Hello Paul Hollywood if you're watching! Oh,

he's a dreamboat isn't he!? [waving]

Matilda H: Er... right... so Mike, what's your plan now?

Mike: Carrying on playing Mariokart of course, I've got a high score!

Exit Matilda and Mrs Teevee (takes gold ticket from Mike to look after), Enter Mike Teevee

SONG 13 - SUPER MARIO - PRESENIOR STREET

MIKE TEEVEE ONLY STARTS ON STAGE – others enter as music starts

Exit PreSenior Street except Mike, enter Ficklegrober

Ficklegrober: Mike Teevee? I see you've found a golden ticket.

Mike: Yes, ticket number four – it's mine!

Ficklegrober: Want to see if you can crack the code to win even more?

Ficklegrober whispers in Mikes ear

Mike nods and follows Ficklegrober off – chatting together as they leave.

Enter Prodnose and Slugworth

Slugworth: Brilliant, that's four ticket winners we've spoken to now

Prodnose: Yes, and all on board with the plan

Slugworth: All we need to do now is wait for that final golden ticket to be found

Prodnose: As long as we get to that final winner and get them to agree, before they enter the factory,

then our mission is complete.

Slugworth: We better look for that last golden ticket winner then!

Exit Prodnose and Slugworth

Enter Candyman (joggers over tap costume, apron – choc bar with ticket inside in apron, hat and bow tie)

Candy Man: I'll be glad when all of this ticket searching is over! The world has gone crazy!

Enter Charlie (leggings and leotard underneath costume) holding a coin

Charlie: Four tickets found, just one left! I can't believe Grandpa Joe thinks I'll find the fifth! He's

even given me this out of his savings. What chance has a Charlie Bucket buying just one chocolate bar have against rich kids who have bought thousands? Well, here it goes...

Charlie walks over to Candy Man

Charlie: Hi, one Wonka bar please – if you have any.

Candy Man: Trying to find a Golden Ticket hey? Well, everywhere is sold out. But I have kept a few

behind, for the most deserving kids to buy. Here (passes the chocolate bar)

Charlie: Thank you [hands coin]

Exit Candy Man, Charlie walks to centre of stage

SONG 13A - TICKET DISCOVERY

As song plays Charlie opens bar and finds ticket, gasps and holds high. Runs off stage. Whilst music playing - enter Grandpa George and Joe holding blanket (just heads), Grandma Josphine and Georgina holding a blanket, and Mrs Bucket holding blanket (just head)

Charlie runs in, everyone wakes up except Josephine, but stays in 'bed'

Charlie: Everyone, wake up! I've found it! The last golden ticket!

Georgina: What do you mean? Where did you get the money?

Charlie: Grandpa Joe gave me enough for a bar, I opened it and, here it is!

Josephine wakes up with a start

Josephine: Dragonflies?!

George: He's done it! He's found the last golden ticket.

ALL: Whooopeeee! [As Mrs Bucket and Grandparents drop the blankets to show their tap

costumes, Grandmas look confused and pick up blanket to get back in bed]

Grandpa George flips across the floor and shouts Woopee!! And runs off

Mrs Bucket: Well, it seems Grandpa George and Grandpa Joe have found their strength!

Mrs Bucket gives her blanket to Grandmas, Charlie and Joe come to front

Joe: I knew you'd do it Charlie!

Charlie: All thanks to you Grandpa Joe, it says I can bring one adult – can I bring you?

Joe hugs Charlie

Joe: Thank you Charlie, yes I'd love to. Now, go get ready, it's time to celebrate.

Charlie runs off

Mrs Bucket: There's someone at the door

Enter PreSenior and Senior Tap.

Megan: We heard the news!

Caitlin: Couldn't happen to a nicer family.

Charlie runs back on

Joe: You've done it Charlie! You've won a Golden Ticket!

Exit Grandma Georgina and Grandma Josephine

SONG 14 – I'VE GOT A GOLDEN TICKET – PRESENIOR AND SENIOR TAP CHARLIE ONLY STARTS ON STAGE – others enter as music starts

Bow, curtains close

INTERVAL

ACT 2

Curtains open, Bill, Bob and Betty on stage holding book.

Bill: Welcome back chocolate lovers

Ben: Are you ready for part two of our story?

Betty: Let's remind you what's happened so far

Bill: Mr Willy Wonka hid golden tickets inside 5 of his chocolate bars

Ben: They were found by Augustus Gloop, Veruca Salt, Violet Boregard, Mike Teevee and...

ALL: Charlie Bucket!

Betty: Today is the day the ticket holders get to visit the factory

Bill: Oh look, there's Charlie getting ready

In Charlie walks holding in his ticket, exit Bill, Ben and Betty

Enter Slugworth, Prodnose and Ficklegrober

Prodnose: Charlie Bucket?

Charlie: Yes that's me

Ficklegrober: Here he is, winner of a Golden Ticket

Prodnose: One of the luckiest boys alive

Slugworth: Is he though? What will a lifetime's supply of chocolate do to help him and his family?

They can barely afford to keep a roof over their head.

Ficklegrober: Perhaps we can help.

Slugworth: Let us introduce ourselves, I'm Angelica Slugworth

Prodnose: Prudence Prodnose

Ficklegrober: Florence Ficklegrober

Charlie: You're Wonka's competitors!

Slugworth: We're chocolatiers, business women. And yes, we're just trying to keep our poor little

businesses alive against the giant that is Wonka and his... creations.

Prodnose: What if we could really help you and your family, Charlie.

Ficklegrober: Now listen carefully because we're going to make you very rich indeed. Mr Wonka is at

this moment working on a fantastic invention – The Everlasting Gobstopper.

Slugworth: If he succeeds he'll ruin us all. So all we want you to do is get us just one Everlasting

Gobstopper

Prodnose: In return, we'll pay you a hundred thousand pounds. Just think – a new house for your

family, and good food and comfort for the rest of their lives.

Slugworth: Don't forget the name..

All 3: Everlasting Gobstopper

Exit Slugworth, Prodnose and Ficklegrober. Enter Grandpa Joe

Grandpa Joe: Charlie! It's time! Mr Willy Wonka is about to let us into the factory.

Exit Grandpa Joe and Charlie, Enter Junior Modern

SONG 15 – WILLY WONKA HERE HE IS/IT'S A KIND OF MAGIC – JUNIOR MODERN START ON STAGE – standing in 4 lines

Exit Junior Modern, Enter Charlie, Grandpa Joe, Augustus, Mrs Gloop, Veruca, Mr Salt, Violet, Mrs Boregard, Mike and Mrs Teevee

Wonka: Welcome, welcome one and all! Does everyone have their ticket?

Violet: [pushing to front] I'll go first! I'm Violet Bouregard – winner and champion

Wonka: [shakes Violets hand and takes ticket] Welcome Violet, and Mrs Boregard

Veruca: [pushing past Violet] I'm Veruca Salt, I like your hat – I have 7 even bigger ones at home

Wonka: [shakes Verucas hand and takes ticket] Lucky you! Welcome Veruca, and Mr Salt

Mike: [confidently walking to Wonka] Mike Teevee, you really need to hide your tickets better –

they were so easy to find.

Wonka: [shakes Mikes hand and takes ticket] Welcome Mike, I'll keep that in mind, hello Mrs

Teevee

Augustus: [walks to Wonka] Augustus Gloop, when do I get my chocolate? I'm so hungry!

Wonka: [shakes Augustus hand and takes ticket] All in good time Augustus! Welcome, and you

too Mrs Gloop

Charlie: [walks to Wonka] I'm Charlie Bucket and this is my Grandpa Joe

Wonka: [shakes Charlies hand and takes ticket] Welcome Charlie and Grandpa Joe, so good to

see you both

Wonka: Right, we're all here. Just the small matter of the contract to sign.

Enter Ben, Bill and Betty with huge contract and pen

Mr Salt: Hang on a minute! The writing is so small I can't see what it says, Veruca's not signing

that!

Veruca: I am Daddy, and you can't stop me!

Veruca grabs contract and signs, all other children then sign. Exit Ben, Bill and Betty with contract

Wonka: Are you ready to let you imagination run wild? Everything you'll see is edible – the trees,

the flowers – it's all sweets and chocolate, the best you'll have ever tasted.

Augustus: I'm so hungry, let me at it! [runs off stage]

Wonka nods to approve everyone goes in. All exit, jostling to be at front

Enter adult ballet

SONG 16 - PURE IMAGINATION - ADULT BALLET

START ON STAGE – sitting with legs to front

Adult Ballet Exit

Enter Wonka and Charlie

Charlie: Mr Wonka, your factory is incredible! But who helps you run it? Who makes the

chocolate?

Wonka: Ah! The Oompa Loompas of course! Loyal, hardworking and trustworthy. They make the

most magnificent chocolate. Here they are now.

Exit Charlie and Wonka. Enter PreInter & Inter Street

Eve T: Oompa Loompas assemble!

Chloe A: Let's get this chocolate made!

Ettie A: {to Lochie} Boss, can we play some funky tunes whilst we work?

Lochie: Definitely! Every Oompa Loompa knows the better the music, the better the chocolate.

Let's go!

SONG 17 – OOMPA LOOMPA STREET ROUTINE – PREINTERMEDIATE AND INTERMEDIATE STREET

START ON STAGE - in formation

Lucy N: I think we've done!

Jess A: The tunes were so good that I bet this will be our best chocolate yet!

Milo R: And our moves were pretty sweet too!

Penny L: Here's the golden ticket winners.

Enter Wonka, Charlie, Grandpa Joe, Augustus, Mrs Gloop, Veruca, Mr Salt, Violet, Mrs Boregard, Mike and

Mrs Teevee.

Veruca: I want an Oompa Loompa Daddy!

Oompa Loompas pull faces and wiggle bottoms at Veruca

Veruca: Actually, I don't want an Oompa Loompa

Wonka: Has all today's chocolate making been completed?

Isla M: All finished Mr Wonka

Emily B: And in record time!

Wonka: Brilliant, you can all take the rest of the day off

PreInter & Inter Street cheer and exit

Enter Gondola Captain

Captain: Mr Wonka, are you all ready for the river cruise?

Wonka: I believe we are

Captain: Brilliant. Crew – bring in the boat

Gondoliers push in boat (two pieces together) to front centre of stage

Captain: Crew, guests – all aboard!

Mrs Teevee: How are we all expected to fit on that tiny boat?

Wonka: Ah yes of course, Captain – grow the boat if you please

Mike: Grow the boat? That's impossible

Gondoliers push boat pieces to front far sides of stage and sit in it

Wonka: Nothing is impossible my dear boy. All aboard! But do stay seated, we wouldn't want to

rock the boat, would we... [Smiles mischievously and winks at the crew]

All climb aboard boat then get into places for dance

SONG 18 – SIT DOWN YOU'RE ROCKING THE BOAT – PRESENIOR AND SENIOR MODERN

After bows, all gondoliers exit (2 push boat together before exit)

Mr Salt: I'm not sure I enjoyed that boat ride Wonka

Mrs Bouregard: And your river is filthy! Look at the colour of the water, it's brown!

Wonka: That's because it's chocolate!

Augustus: A river of chocolate?! Oh my! I'm so hungry – I'm going in!!

Augustus steps into small boat and jumps off other side shouting WAHOOO! Everyone looks shocked

Mrs Gloop: My baby! He can't swim! Someone dive in, save him!

Wonka: Don't worry Mrs Gloop, the suction will get him.

Mrs Gloop: Suction!? Oh my precious prince is going to be made in to marshmellows!

Wonka: Impossible! That tube doesn't go to the marshmellow room. ... It goes to the fudge room!

Just head that way Mrs Gloop, the Oompa Loompas will show you where to go.

Mrs Gloop: You terrible man!

Mrs Gloop: [as running off] Don't worry, mummy's coming my little snookums!

Wonka: Erm, well that was ...unfortunate. Come along now everyone, we have so much time and

so little to see – wait a minute, strike that, reverse it!

All exit -2x pushing boat off and Augustus rolling off

SONG 19 – SUGAR PLUM FAIRY – PREINTERMEDIATE BALLET

START OFF STAGE – dance on from both sides as music starts

After curtsey, preinter ballet stay on stage. Enter Wonka, Charlie, Joe, Violet, Mrs Bouregard, Veruca, Mr Salt, Mike Teevee, Mrs Teevee

Mike: What are these sweets?

Wonka: These are my latest creation, Everlasting Gobstoppers

Veruca: Did you say Everlasting Gobstoppers

Wonka: Yes, my latest creation – old Slugworth, Prodnose and Ficklegrober would give their right

arm to get one of these!

Veruca: Can we have one?

Wonka: Erm, ok yes – as long as you promise to keep it for yourself, never give it to anyone else

Violet, Veruca and Mike cross fingers behind back (so audience can see!)

Kids: We promise

Wonka gives a preinter to each of the kids and they hold hands (can be done at random)

Wonka: Put them in your bags, you wouldn't want to lose them. I'll get this lot back in their boxes

Inter ballet lead off stage, ticket winners return

Violet: [Pointing to other side] What's this over here? Is it gum?! I have a world record for

chewing gum!

Violet head other side stage and pretends to pick up the gum

Mrs Bouregard: [proudly] The longest chew ever – she ever stuck it behind her ear whilst asleep!

Wonka: That little piece of gum is a three course dinner!

Violet: I need to try it!

Wonka: I wouldn't, it's not quite right yet.

Violet puts gum in mouth and chews

Violet: Oh my – this tastes like tomato soup! Now it's roast beef and potatos!

Mrs Bouregard: What's for pudding champ?

Violet: Blueberry pie, it's delicious

Mike: Why is your face turning blue?

Mrs Bouregard: Violet! You're turning violet, Violet!

Mr Salt: And she's blowing up like a balloon!!

All crowd around Violet talking and looking shocked, blueberry cut out discreetly comes on stage (FROM

LEFT) and given to violet

Wonka: It always goes wrong at desert.... They always turn into...

All step away

Violet: A blueberry!

Mrs Bouregard: Mr Wonka! What have you done to my daughter?! How will she compete looking like a

blueberry?

Veruca: You could enter her into a harvest festival!

Wonka: We better squeeze the juice out of her before she pops! The squeezing room is way Mrs

Bouregard

Exit Violet and Mrs Bouregard

Wonka: Another one gone – oh dear!

Right, onward everyone! Next we have our sorting squirrels – they sort all the nuts we use to see if they're good or bad. ...and they have a surprisingly good taste in HipHop

music!

Exit all, enter Junior Street

SONG 20 - SQUIRRELS STREET DANCE - JUNIOR STREET

START ON STAGE – boss Squirrel (Ella) to place

After bow Junior Street stay, enter Wonka, Veruca and Mr Salt

Veruca: oh Daddy, I want a sorting squirrel!

Mr Salt: Ok Mr Wonka, how much for a squirrel?

Wonka: They're not for sale

Veruca: What!? I want a squirrel! I'll just take one then.

Squirrels surround Veruca, stare at her, then face Wonka and shake head looking angry. Squirrels then push and lead Veruca away off stage

Wonka: Oh dear, they think she's a bad nut!

Mr Salt: A bad nut?! They can't do that! Veruca! Come back!.....

Mr Salt runs off stage after Veruca

Wonka shrugs and leaves other side, enter pointe

SONG 21 - VERUCA NUTCRACKER SUITE - POINTE

START ON STAGE – starting poses

Exit pointe, enter Wonka, Mrs Teevee and Mike

Mike: Where did the ballerina's come from?

Mrs Teevee: Yes Mr Wonka, all seems a little strange. Very choregraphed.

Mike: And the song, it has Veruca's name in it?

Wonka: Well erm, my Oompa Loompa's have many talents! Onwards everyone, we have the fizzy

lifting room next. My new range of that lift their drinkers into the sky!

Exit all, enter ballet 3, Bubble machines blow during dance

SONG 22 – I'M FOREVER BLOWING BUBBLES – BALLET 3

START ON STAGE – in pairs – Adele may need to arrange spacing

Exit Ballet 3, bubbles keep blowing, enter Grandpa Joe and Charlie, carrying bottles of fizzy lifting drinks

Grandpa Joe: Shall we have a try of these fizzing lifting drink?

Charlie: I don't think Mr Wonka said we were allowed

Grandpa Joe: A small drink won't harm us

Joe and Charlie have a sip

Charlie: I feel funny!

Joa and Charlie act to be floating

Grandpa Joe: Oh Charlie! We're flying! Isn't this fun?!

Charlie: But we're going too high! Look Grandpa, the fan! It'll chop us to bits!

Grandpa Joe: Burps loudly Oh pardon me! Hang on, I'm going down, Charlie you need to burp!

Charlie: Burps loudly

Both jump to land on floor.

Charlie: That was close!

Grandpa Joe: Yes, maybe we should catch up with the group!

Grandpa Joe and Charlie exit, enter Wonka, Mike, Mrs Teevee, and all commercial who are ready

Commercial stand across back miming filming, typing on computers and doing science

Mike: I like the look of this room, what's going on here?

Wonka: Ah, this is Wonkavision – we're going to use it to send chocolate to far off places and to

children who can't get it. The only thing is, the chocolate we send has to be massive, as

it shrinks in the process

Mike: Wow! Does it have to be chocolate? Could you send other things, like... people?

Wonka: In theory, yes... but I wouldn't...

Mike: Brilliant! I'm going to be the first person to be teleported! Runs off stage

Commercial take starting position

Wonka: We better take cover! {take Mrs Teevee's arm and runs off stage]

SONG 23 - APPLAUSE - SENIOR COMMERCIAL

START ON STAGE - in circle

Exit Commercial, Enter Charlie, Grandpa Joe and Mrs Teevee

Wonka: Erm, Mrs Teevee I believe this belongs to you... [pulls small Mike Teevee out of pocket]

Mrs Tevee: Mike!!! You're tiny!!

Wonka: I'm sure he'll stretch, small boys are very springy! The stretching room is that way

Mrs Teevee takes small mike and leaves stage

Wonka: And there goes the last, what a wasted day!

Charlie: I'm still here Mr Wonka

Grandpa Joe: Does he get the prize now?

Wonka: No! You lost! Did you not read the contract!? You both stole fizzy lifting drinks, my fans

need to be cleaned and sanitised. You lose.

Grandpa Joe: You can't do that Wonka! Build up a boys hopes and dreams and then take them away!

Come along Charlie... if Slugworth and her friends want an Everlasting Gobstopper, we'll

give them one

Exit Grandpa Joe and Charlie

Curtains close

RAFFLE

ACT 3

Curtains open Wonka standing looking sad, enter Charlie brings on one of the preinter ballet gobstoppers, looks at her and then leads to Mr Wonka

Charlie: Mr Wonka, I've decided to give you the Everlasting Gobstopper back

Wonka: And so one good deed deserves another.... My dear boy, you've won!!

Charlie: Have I? The lifetime supply of chocolate?

Wonka: Yes! And so much more! I'm giving you my factory!

Charlie: Wow! Thank you Mr Wonka!

Wonka and Charlie hug, enter PreSenior and Senior Contemporary

SONG 24 – MOUNTAIN – PRESENIOER AND SENIOR CONTEMPORARY

½ group START ON STAGE – in vertical line

Exit all except Charlie and Wonka

Charlie: I can't believe you're giving me the factory! But what about my family?

Wonka: They can live here too! In fact, you've made me ready to trust people again. We'll open

the doors, let the children in, the Oompa Loompas can do tours!

[speaking to offstage] Quick - Beryl, Mavis - come here! And call that sweet shop

owner, I'm sure he'll help too with his expert knowledge!

Enter Adele, Sarah as Oompa Loompas and Anna as the candy man.

Candy Man: Yes Mr Wonka?

Wonka: Let's do tours of the factory

Candy Man: Great idea! Let's start with Ballet 1. Are there any Ballet 1 children in the audience that

would like to come and join us onstage for our first ever tour?

SONG 25 – A WORLD OF YOUR OWN – BALLET 1

START ON STAGE – 2 lines with Sarah and Anna on stage, Adele in/near wings

Candy Man: For the next part of the tour, we're going to the finale room! So ballet 1, and any other

dancer sitting in the audience, follow me through this magical door - you'll need you finale

tshirts and black leggings on for this room!

Exit ballet 1 down front stairs and through dining hall door, plus any children from audience

SONG 25A –INSTRUMENTAL – play this while ballet 1 leave etc

Close curtains whilst music plays

Enter Wonka, Charlie and Grandpa Joe through curtains

Grandpa Joe: Will the other children be ok Mr Wonka?

Wonka: Yes Grandpa Joe, they'll all return to their normal selves, but hopefully they'll be a little

wiser and kinder.

Charlie: I think I'm going to enjoy these factory tours Mr Wonka

Wonka: Yes! we need to share our pure imagination with everyone – open the doors, it's time to

celebrate Charlie and his Chocolate Factory!

SONG 26 - FINALE

Open Curtains whilst music plays, exit Wonka, Charlie, Joe, All exit for finale

Adele Speech - thank you's and exit instructions

After show finishes repeat Track 1 (intro) then interval playlist
